Dear Parents and Guardians:

We anticipate that report cards for the third marking period will be available on the parent portal on or about April 25<sup>th</sup>. As always, please remind your child to take advantage of the NHS tutoring held every Tuesday and Wednesday, from 3:30 to 4:30 p.m., in the Lloyd Library.

The district budget vote and Board of Education election will take place on Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup>. The polls are open from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. The vote will take place in the Cochran Gym. I urge each of you to get out and vote.

Seniors will be released from classes beginning May 20<sup>th</sup> in order to fulfill their senior internship responsibility. There will be a number of events for seniors, including the prom, during the week of June 17<sup>th</sup>. Prom tickets go on sale beginning Monday, April 1<sup>st</sup>. The senior awards will be on June 20<sup>th</sup>, and commencement on Saturday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

AP exams are being administered May 6<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup>. Once again, AP exams will be administered at the Hastings Public Library. You will receive more specific information from the Guidance Department. Students are excused from class to write the exam at the scheduled time. Students who write an AP exam are expected to attend the rest of their classes unless excused by a parent. Those permission slips are available in the High School office. In the latter situation, excused students are expected to go home.
