

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL DISTRICT MEETING
HASTINGS-ON-HUDSON UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
IN THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Education of the Hastings-on-Hudson Union Free School District, in the County of Westchester, New York, adopted on January 7, 2019, a Special District Meeting of the qualified voters of said School District will be held on

Thursday, February 28, 2019

from 7:00 o'clock A.M. to 9:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) at the Cochran Gym of the Hastings High School, 1 Mt. Hope Boulevard, Hastings-on-Hudson, New York, for the purpose of voting upon the following Bond Proposition:

BOND PROPOSITION

RESOLVED:

(a) That the Board of Education of the Hastings-on-Hudson Union Free School District, Westchester County, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to construct improvements to Hillside Elementary School, Farragut Middle School and Hastings High School and to construct an addition to Hillside Elementary School, (collectively, the "Project") substantially as described in a report prepared for the District by H2M architects + engineers, DPC (the "Plan"), which is on file and available for public inspection at the office of the District Clerk, such Project to include the construction of a building addition to provide additional classroom, cafeteria/auditorium and other space; the construction of building envelope improvements, including masonry, exterior wall, chimney and parapet enhancements; roof, window and floor replacements; interior reconstruction and space reconfiguration, the installation of a new elevator, and improvements to the heating and public address systems; all of the foregoing to include the original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus and ancillary or related site, demolition and other work required in connection therewith; and to expend therefor, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof, an amount not to exceed the estimated total cost of \$18,383,614; provided that the estimated costs of the components of the Project as set forth in the Plan may be reallocated among such components if the Board of Education shall determine that such reallocation is in the best interest of the District;

(b) that a tax in the amount of not to exceed \$18,383,614 is hereby voted to pay the cost of the Project, such tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as shall be determined by said Board of Education; and

(c) that in anticipation of said tax, bonds of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of not to exceed \$18,383,614, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable.

Such Bond Proposition shall appear on the ballots used for voting at said Special District Meeting in substantially the following condensed form:

RESOLVED:

(a) That the Board of Education of the Hastings-on-Hudson Union Free School District, Westchester County, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to construct improvements to Hillside Elementary School, Farragut Middle School and Hastings High School and to construct an addition to Hillside Elementary School; and to expend \$18,383,614 therefor; (b) that a tax in the amount of not to exceed \$18,383,614 is hereby voted to pay such cost, such tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as shall be determined by said Board of Education; and (c) that in anticipation of said tax, bonds of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of not to exceed \$18,383,614, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable.

The voting will be conducted by ballot on voting machines or paper ballot as provided in the Education Law and the polls will remain open from 7:00 o'clock A.M. to 9:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) and as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their ballots.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that members of the Board of Registration shall meet on Thursday, February 21, 2019, from 4:00 o'clock P.M. to 8:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) at the Lobby of the Hastings High School, 1 Mt. Hope Boulevard, Hastings-on-Hudson,

New York, for the purpose of preparing a register of the qualified voters of the District for said Special District Meeting, at which time any person shall be entitled to have his/her name placed upon such register, provided that at such meeting of the Board of Registration he/she is known or proven to the satisfaction of such Board of Registration to be then or thereafter entitled to vote at said Special District Meeting.

The register of the qualified voters of said District prepared for the Annual District Meeting and Election held on May 15, 2018, shall be used by said Board of Registration as the basis for the preparation of the register for said Special District Meeting to be held on February 28, 2019. Any person whose name appears on such register or who shall have been previously registered for any annual or special District meeting or election and who shall have voted at any annual or special District meeting or election held or conducted at any time since January 1, 2015, will not be required to register personally for this Special District Meeting. In addition, any person otherwise qualified to vote who is registered with the Board of Elections of Westchester County under the provisions of the Election Law shall be entitled to vote at said Special District Meeting without further registration.

Immediately upon its completion, said register will be filed in the Office of the District Clerk, and will be open for inspection by any qualified voter of the District from February 22, 2019, to the day of the Special District Meeting, February 28, 2019, Sunday excepted, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 4:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time), with the exception of Saturday, February 23, 2014, by appointment only from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 12:00 o'clock Noon (Prevailing Time).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots may be applied for at the office of the District Clerk. If the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, the completed

application must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) on February 21, 2019. If the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter at the office of the District Clerk, the completed application must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) on February 27, 2019.

A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the office of the District Clerk between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 4:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) on each of the five (5) days prior to the day of the election, except Saturday and Sunday.

Only qualified voters who are registered to vote will be permitted to vote.
