

HIEROGLYPH ALPHABET CHART

This chart tells you how to stamp out your messages in hieroglyphs. For most of the letters in the English alphabet, there is one corresponding hieroglyph. There are some exceptions. Vowels and some other letters have more than one sound, so you must choose the right hieroglyph by looking at the examples and reading the explanations. As the chart shows, to stamp out g, x, and long u, you must combine two hieroglyphs. You can use one stamp to represent the letters ch, ph, sh, or th.

	reed	bl, bja	Use one reed leaf for both the short and the long l sounds.

	basket	gggn, gggn, gggn	Combine the basket (B) and the quail chick (Q) to make the gg sound in words like gggn and gggn.
