Grade 6 School Supply List for 2022-2023

Hastings Parents,

The following is a grid indicating what supplies are requested for each subject. Teachers make recommendations based on what works for most students considering the needs in that particular class. If it appears at some point during the year that this organizational system isn't working, feel free to discuss other options with the team. Students are encouraged to develop their own strategy for organizing their materials. For example, they may consider designating a color for each subject so that they can be sure to take the right materials.

Please label all items with the student's first and last name (using a sharpie) before bringing them to school on the first day, September 6. Teachers will be instructing students how to use these supplies during the first week. We don't recommend locker decorations (chandelier, rugs, lights etc). However, a magnetic pencil holder is useful. Students will be issued a locker and are expected to leave their bookbags and coat (and phone if they have one) in their locker during the school day. Students will be issued an agenda book as well.

All students at FMS are issued Chromebooks. Students are expected to bring their device to school each day and be in the habit of charging it at home. The charge should last the full day and students who need to charge in school should plan to bring their charger as well as classrooms may not have a compatible charger. Academic activities will not always be reliant on technology, however, at times, and for some classes, students will need to access Google Classroom as well as work on Google docs and access the internet.

General Supplies to keep at school (in locker)

- **one large pencil case** to bring to all classes and to be filled with supplies needed on a daily basis (pencils/pens/ sharpeners/ erasers) INCLUDING ear buds. Label clearly with your name. **erasers**
- **inexpensive earbuds or small headphones:** 1 pair (to keep in pencil case) plus one extra, if possible, for when the first one gets lost.
- 5 dozen - #2 pencils. Put a few in the pencil case and leave the rest in the locker.
- pens: 3 red; 3 blue; 3 black. Put one of each in pencil case and leave the rest in the locker.
- **2 black super-fine Sharpie** Keep in pencil case.
- 2 packages of loose-leaf paper. Load some into binder in each section. Keep one extra package in locker and one at home.
- manual pencil sharpener with cap. Keep one in pencil case and one at home.

- **For classroom use. Bring to school on the first day:**

2 boxes of **tissues** to homeroom teacher

Last name: A-K **1 box/container/package of wipes** to homeroom teacher

Last name: L-Z **1 roll paper towels** to science teacher

OTHER USEFUL SUPPLIES for use at home. There is no need to purchase these if you already have them.

- assorted drawing tools: highlighters, markers, crayons, colored pencils, etc.
- assorted fasteners: stapler and staples, paper clips, glue, tape; scissors
- Throughout the year, students may be assigned projects. It may be convenient to purchase 1 or 2 pieces of poster board (not foam board) in advance. However, ample notice will be given before a project is due if you would like to purchase project supplies as needed.
